Carol Ann Howlett (Kincheloe), age 92, passed on to heaven on May 7, 2024. Carol was born on May 26, 1931 to Philip and Mary Haskell. She was the youngest of four, and always close to her siblings - Philip, Richard, and Mary Dale. The family moved from Milwaukee, Wisconsin to Bakersfield, California during her high school years. After graduating from Garces High School, she attended Bakersfield College, then Fresno State College where she earned her teaching credential.

In 1950, she married Lewis Charles Howlett at St. Francis Church. They had four children - Lois (Jim) Gall, Jeanne (Michael) Young, Chuck Howlett, and Beth (Joe) Berry. Carol and Lewis owned and operated Lewis Cabinets for numerous years prior to his accidental death in 1971, along with their only son. Carol continued to run the cabinet shop after Lewis' death for many years, along with the help of her father and brother. After selling the business, she returned to teaching for several more years.

Carol was known for her infectious laugh at the silliest of jokes, playing cards with family and friends, and the kindness that she showed to all those she knew. Carol gained many friends over her lifetime. We thank all of you who enriched her life with your friendship. Each of you truly shared God's love on earth with her and our family.

Carol is survived by her 3 daughters, 10 grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren, and many nieces, nephews, and bonus family members. She

was proceeded in death by her parents, siblings, husband, and son.
