Earlene Naylor was born in 1932 and raised in the LA basin during a time when she could ride her horse in the LA River and through bountiful orange groves. She was a daredevil from the beginning. With every fall from her horse, her mother would say, “You’ll never live to be forty!” That prediction proved to be false, but Earlene’s fearless nature continued throughout her life. As a young woman, she was an avid water skier. She prided herself in skiing the entire 18-mile length of Pine Flat Dam. She and her husband, W. L. “Squidd” Naylor, switched to dirt bike riding near California City. She was the only woman who rode regularly with the men and could climb hills with the best of them.

As they got older, they switched to street bikes. Earlene rode behind Squidd twice and they immediately bought a second bike. They rode all over the United States. After Squidd passed away, she continued to ride on her own. Then she met Gil LaLonde who shared her love of motorcycles. They, too, traveled all over the country and added trips to motorcycle rallies like Sturgis and Americade. Over her lifetime, she logged over 350,000 miles on a motorcycle!

She loved her family dearly and was especially proud of her grandsons, Dennis and Kevin Anderson. She looked forward to any event that enabled her to see “her boys!” She was especially pleased when they learned to water ski and ride dirt bikes.

Earlene is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Dianna and Ron

Anderson, her grandson Dennis and his wife Sarah, and her other grandson Kevin Anderson. She is also survived by her younger sisters Ruth Hale and Kathy Blevins.
