



Luciano "Luke" Ramos Carrasco

It is with deep sadness that we announce the passing of Luciano(Luke) Carrasco, a beloved father, grandfather, great grandfather, brother and devoted partner.

He was born on January 7, 1938, in Midland, Texas. When he was young, the family moved to Shafter, CA.

Luke attended Shafter High School, where he sang in the choir, played saxophone in the band, lettered in Track and graduated in 1957. After graduation, he proudly enlisted in the U.S Marine Corp. He was a member of the US Marine Corps Band and played for the 11th Marine Regiment Drum & Bugle Corps. He also played for a local military Marine band, the Pendleton Playboys, showcasing his musical talents on the drums. He served his country with honor and was honorably discharged in 1960.

In July of 1959 he married Angie, and welcomed four wonderful children into the world. Luke built a successful career as a concrete contractor. After retirement he was recruited as a construction superintendent developing apartment complexes.

A deep man of faith, Luke was a Grand Knight and a Fourth Degree member of the Knights of Columbus, where he contributed tirelessly to the community.

He cherished moments spent with his children on weekend trips to Greenhorn Mountain, fishing and camping at Lake San Antonio, and riding three-wheelers together across the sand dunes at Pismo Beach.
