William “Bill” Newman, aged 90, of Bakersfield, CA, passed away on June 29th, surrounded by his loving family.

Bill was born on November 5, 1934, in Rossville, Texas, to Elbert Newman and Sadie Beauchamp-Newman. After graduating high school, he joined the U.S. Air Force and served as a radio operator stationed in French Morocco and Germany during the Korean War.

brother-in-law, Robert Braucht.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Bonita Newman, and his sister, Farolee "Jackie" Barron.
